Parent/Student Contract

- This contract is a guideline for the parents and students connected with our community.
- This contract must be signed *every fall*.
(We prefer the contract to be turned in between September 1-30)
- It is expected that each family sign this contract before attending an overnight trip.
(Exceptions will only be made for students who are new.)
- By signing this contract parents will be given access to register for events online.
- Each student must have their own contract.

Parents/Guardians

+Please give clear instructions to your teen about what your expectations for them are after youth group activities: who they are allowed to drive with, when they are allowed to leave.

+ Youth activities are not a drop-off/pick-up location for students not attending the activity.

+Junior High:

+Youth Group ends at 8:30 PM on Thursdays (students are allowed to stay in building as long as an adult leader is present)

High School:

+Youth Group ends at 8:15 PM on Sundays (students are allowed to stay in building as long as an adult leader is present)

+Students attending Coffeehouse must “login” when entering the building and “logout” when exiting the building. Students are not allowed to return after leaving unless their parents have given approval.

+We strongly encourage parents to check their email regularly for updates on youth group activities and to read the monthly Parent Youth Connection newsletter.

Students

+Be respectful of God, each other, and yourself.

When students choose to be disrespectful to our adult leadership we will pull that student out of the group until they are ready to be respectful.

+We will clean up the area we have used.

Students must help clean up the rooms/van we have used before going home.

+We will use appropriate language with one another.

Swearing, gossiping, and speaking negatively about others is not Christ-honoring.

+Our church is a public building so please do not bring expensive electronics and personal items into the building. (The church is not responsible for these items.)

Trips

+Cell phones and other electronic devices are not allowed on overnight trips: weekend retreats, serving experiences, summer trips.

We have discovered that electronics are a distraction from learning and connecting with the people around us. Students may use an adult leader's phone to call home.

+Parents must always fill out a permission form before every trip.

[A trip is defined as any activity where we leave the church campus, except for local serving.]

Permission forms protect the church against liabilities and assures us that parents know where their child is.

+Respect Policy on Trips: If a student is excessively disrespectful, we will follow this guideline: 1st offense: student will be "buddy-ed" with adult leader for the day; 2nd offense: phone call to parents; 3rd offense: student is sent home at their expense

Public Display of Affection [PDA]

We want our community to be a safe community where all students feel included. We want to encourage each other toward Christ-honoring, pure lifestyles.

The following Public (or Private) Displays of Affection toward the opposite sex are not acceptable during youth group and church sponsored activities: Extended hugging, kissing, hand-holding, sitting on one another, and being in a room alone together

Clothing

Being modest is not about what you wear, it is about your demeanor. *As Christians, we are called to be people who put God and His values at the center of our lives and let that reflect in all we do.* The Bible says, "We are the aroma of Christ" (2 Corinthians 2:15). This means that people can "smell" who Jesus is through the actions of His followers! We represent God in how we act, talk, and dress. We want to represent Him well. *Dressing modestly is about respect; respecting God, respecting yourself, and respecting others.*

We ask that you follow these steps with us at all youth group activities and hopefully on your own:

Girls

Tops: Please consider tops with straps more than "2 fingers" wide or tank tops instead. If the shirt has a low v-neck or shows your midriff, please put a shirt underneath it. If the top is particularly tight or form fitting, please consider wearing a looser one.

Bottoms: Please consider wearing skirts and shorts that are at least mid-thigh length and do not have words on the derrière. (For missions trips they must be to your knees.). Pants that ride low are not the best option: they often show too much tummy or lower back.

Swimwear: One-piece or tankinis are good. Bathing suits with a tank top over it are good too.

Boys

Shirts need to be worn at all times unless at the beach.

Please do not wear low hanging pants that display your boxers.

Please consider wearing shirts with sleeves.

All

If you can bend over and touch your toes without showing any skin or underwear in the back, then your shirt and pants are okay. If you can raise your hands all the way above your head and not show your stomach or underwear, then your shirt is okay.)
